Changes in Income Tax relief on contribution to charities since 6 April 2000 mean that the church can reclaim tax at the basic rate on all donations made by UK tax-payers, whatever the amount, without going through the procedure of a Deed of Covenant.

4. The total amount of the tax you pay each year must exceed the tax on the donation you make – currently 25p for each £1 you give
